I Howard S. Annis Jr. to affirm the following: I enjoyed the Green Harbor River summers from 1947 through 1952 (age 10 through 16). I lived on the island in the river for part of each of those summers with my Aunt Sally Powers, my cousin (Sally Ann Doyle) and my sister.

I used to catch Blue Lighting crabs and my Aunt Sally would make a potato and crab meat salad. My cousin and I would wade in mud at the head of the island for quahogs. We sold them for bait (\$1.00 a bushel). The quahogs were not edible because of both salt and fresh water present. Horseshoe crabs and eels were also found in these waters.

The tide always effected the height of the water. Mud flats or sand bars would appear at low tide and our boat would be sitting in very low water. The water always had a salty taste, but was always clean. My Aunt Sally would fish for crabs with the head of a fish. She could see the crab at the bottom and would slowly coach the crab to the surface and then net him.
